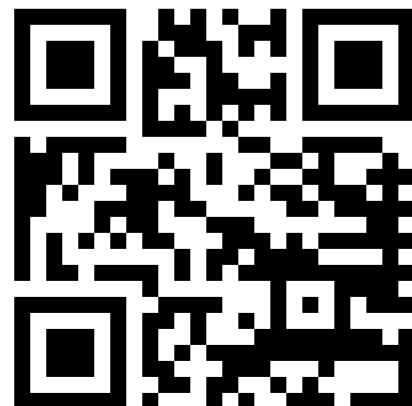
Honey bees are most "sensitive" in the Spring as they need to protect their colonies and make more honey!
